

Thank you so much for signing up to help with our Spring Yard Clean Up this season. Every year Eras Senior Network provides outdoor chore services to help prepare our clients yards for the coming season.

Due to the current health situation in our world right now we have a few updates and changes on how our program will run this year. Please read the information below so that we are all following the recommended guidelines.

When Can I Volunteer?

- While the Safer at Home Order is still in effect, services coordinated by Eras Senior Network have been deemed an essential business organization. Volunteers are able to start completing the work at their assigned yards whenever it makes sense for you.

Can I Volunteer With Other People?

- Small groups (no more than 4 in a group) or families who are already living together may complete the work as a group
- For individuals who are not currently living together, please follow the guidelines below
 - For a **small yard** (¼ acre or less) **2 unrelated people** may volunteer together
 - For a **medium yard** (¼ acre – 1 acre) **3 unrelated people** may volunteer together
 - For a **large yard** (1+ acres) **4 unrelated people** may volunteer together

Anything Else I Should Keep In Mind?

- Continue practicing social distancing (stay at least 6 feet apart from one another)
- All volunteers should use a face covering while they are completing their volunteer work
- Refrain from face to face contact with the client, instead call them when you arrive and when you plan to leave
- Do not go into the client's house for any reason (i.e. bathroom use, telephone calls, etc.)
- Use your own equipment instead of the client's tools
- Do not accept any treats from the client or bring anything for the client
